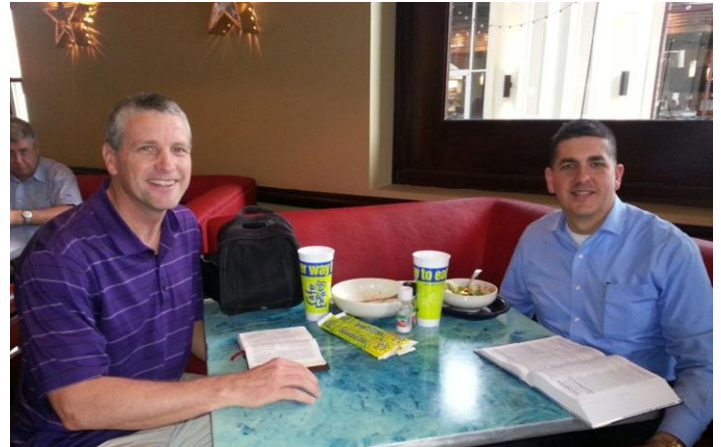


Testimony of a man getting disciplined to know God through His Word
