That evening they graciously guided us through the steps of turning off our water, draining our pipes and protecting our home. We did our best to physically get ready for the storm. But as the regional electric power grid around us failed, the pipes burst. Fortunately, we caught the leaks quickly and not a lot of interior damage was done, unlike thousands of other residents who had horrific damage to their homes.

So, while we had readied our house physically, the point of this book is "readying" your heart spiritually for life's storms. Preparing for the discomfort, stress and anxiety that accompany storms! With power outages, came uncertainty. With pipes bursting, came anxiety. With rolling blackouts, came instability. My favorite passage to gain perspective on suffering is Romans 5:3-5. Trials bring about perseverance, "and perseverance, proven character; and proven character, hope". I kept repeating this to myself during that week. I had my moments, but God is faithful! Let's all keep preparing our hearts for when the storms, as they inevitably will, come!
