

Bold Biblical Comments Draw Men to Discipleship!

Recently more men have started asking Darin to meet for discipleship as he **makes biblical comments** in daily interactions. For example, at 5:30 a.m. Darin's basketball 5 on 5 group didn't work out, which left him alone with a college player who listened as D initiated ideas about hoops and following Christ. Later, this player's passion for sports and knowing more from the Bible made him txt: **"hey Darin this is... [you met] this week early in the morning. I just started reading the book you gave me and WOW. I would love to grab lunch this week and talk about it. Imk whenever you're available"** (at lunch he told his story with a huge hunger to study God's Word together!).

Another man hears Darin **share some clarifying Scripture** on multi-city Bible Study calls that happen wkly: a comment by Darin occurred in contrast to the current lesson's discussion on miraculous healings (an important matter that in our opinion gets helpfully covered by well-known teachers such as John MacArthur, et al). With Ephesians 4:15 in mind and speaking the truth in love, Darin appreciated the following email later that day:

"Good evening, Darin:

I hope this email finds you well. In attending... Bible Studies... I am seeing more and more that I believe as you do. It is refreshing to hear your input and I feel that I could grow closer in Jesus under your instruction. I will be 29 this year and will be marrying my long-time girlfriend in September. We plan on having a family shortly, thereafter, and I want to have a deeper foundation in God and scripture to lead my young family. Please let me know if I will be able to meet with you for lunch sometime to discuss this further... Thank you for your time and I hope you have a good night."
