Discipleship Luncheon makes an impact on men!

We recently had a luncheon to gather businessmen interested in hearing about discipleship through LOGOS Leaders Outreach. About 35 men heard an explanation of how discipleship involves learning God's Word with another man. Darin emphasized that everyone can and should consider to make disciples like this as part of the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20. A businessman named Dan at the luncheon shared specifics of how Darin's discipleship with him has changed his life. He used the acronym FEAST to give five word pictures of God working in his life (email us if you want his detailed descriptions of these!): Focus; Experience; Action; Sustain; Truth.

Also at the event, Darin introduced two of the men he has in a 2 Timothy 2:2 disciple chain who would agree with Dan that discipleship has changed their lives (pictured with their godly and grateful wives below!). Darin disciples one of the men, who then meets with the other man. They study and memorize the Gospel of John as a way to apply the Word to what they need to deal with daily in life. All the wives share in this ministry, as Allison does discipleship with the first man's wife who has impacted the wife of the other man.

Our good friend and biblical speaker David Moore (http://www.twocities.org), spoke at the luncheon from Proverbs 6-9. Dave motivated everyone to take time studying Scripture.

He gave us this motivation by showing the greater benefit of gaining God's Wisdom from His Word in comparison to anything the world has to offer us.
