# The benefit of the One Year Bible and filling our lives with Scripture


In discipling men, nothing stands out more than the challenge to spend time in God's Word. Men have such busy lives, that all the stress of our activities makes it difficult to stop on a regular basis and hear God speak to us from the Scriptures He's given to guide us daily. All our relationships, work and ministry need God's Spirit using His Word in us. A Christian leader named John even shared with Darin how he'd learned recently that "the language of the Holy Spirit is the Bible" (mentioned at one of Darin's recent discipleship times with him). Jesus Himself explained the need to hear and feed ourselves on God's Word in Matthew 4:4,

# Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

Even the Son of God used God's Word for guidance to resist a temptation in the same way we need to. To get fed daily, Darin has used the One Year Bible pictured to the right long enough to have pages needing a rubber band and it helps to have passages online now at <u>logosleadersoutreach.org</u>. In fact, the ministry sends a lesson from the One Year Bible each morning to about 400 people for them to better know God and make Him known.

Matthew 18:32-35 (New International Version - UK Bible with all of these passages given for today from the One Year Bible: Exodus 5:22-7:25; Matthew 18:21-19:12; Psalm 23; Proverbs 5:22-23)

32 'Then the master called the servant in. "You wicked servant," he said, "I cancelled all that debt of yours because you begged me to. 33 Shouldn't you have had mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you?" 34 In anger his master handed him over to the jailers to be tortured, until he should pay back all he owed. 35 'This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother or sister from your heart.'

#### What did I learn about God?

God feels so strongly about people forgiving each other, especially it seems among Christian brothers who've received His forgiveness, that he'd make life torturous for an unforgiving person.

#### What difference does this make in my life?

Like yesterday, I need to forgive from the heart others and in particular other Christians who sin against me.

#### How can this reading help me disciple men?

I'll encourage Christians to make sure we feel like we've fully forgiven anyone who has hurt us, starting in church.
